

Archaeological Field Technicians

We are seeking several individuals who would be available to work on an as needed, temporary basis this summer at specified rural Minnesota locations and in surrounding states. Consistency of work will depend on project workload. Projects could start as early as May and run into August. Work would typically be on weekdays but some weekend or holiday work may be required. Work consists of archaeological survey and testing. Hotels and per diem will be provided on projects that are more than 50 miles away from Duluth. Wage rates range between \$13.00 and \$15.00/hour and is based on qualifications and experience.

Positions require the following: knowledge of archaeological field methods, read/write in English, operate a motor vehicle, navigate by compass and GPS in backcountry terrain, hike up to 10 miles per day while carrying up to 50lbs of equipment, experience with backcountry work, basic knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel, possess a valid driver's license, and be willing to travel. Technicians must provide their own trowel, metric tape measure, and backpack.

Two types of positions are available:

- **Senior Field Technician Minimum Requirements:** BA/BS in anthropology or archaeology, including the completion of an archaeological field school, and two years experience in the field of archaeology.
- **Junior Field Technician Minimum Requirements:** Must have completed an archaeological field school and have or be in the process of obtaining a BA/BS in anthropology or archaeology.
