General duties of the position will include: designing and managing various construction projects for federal and commercial clients; assist in preparing estimates/bids; plan, execute, monitor and control construction projects to successful conclusions (client satisfied, profit goal achieved); interact with clients; provide status reports to senior management. Attend site visits to determine existing conditions, develop client needs in detail, and develop preliminary approximations of types of materials and labor required. Assist in preparing estimates based on technical specifications and drawings or sketches; where feasible provide possible value engineering suggestions.

Requirements also include a degree in electrical engineering with a Professional Engineer certification; current and active project experience with military/federal government construction projects; ability to manage others, and knowledge of labor issues. Must possess a valid driver's license and be able to travel up to 50%. Computer skills required include Microsoft Project, Word, Excel, and Outlook, with Primavera a plus. Candidates must have 10 years related experience in engineering and/or construction management and knowledge of building trades, e.g., plumbing, HVAC, etc.
